**Constitution** — The basic set of rules and principles on which the U.S. government is based; **Filip Vujanovic** — The current president of Montenegro; **Louisa May Alcott** — 19th century American novelist; **Nicolas I** — Montenegro's first and only king; **Supreme Court** — The highest court in the United States; **Tarahumara** — A member of the native people of northwestern Mexico.

**freedom of speech** — The right to express any opinions without restraint; **huarache** — A type of leather sandal originally worn by Mexican Indians; **hybrid** — In this case, the offspring of two animals of different species; **indigenous** — Originating naturally in a particular place; **invasive species** — A species of plant or animal that is brought to an area and endangers its native species; **justice** — In this case, a judge on the U.S. Supreme Court; **python** — A large, heavy-bodied constrictor snake usually found in the tropics; **referendum** — A general vote by the public on a single political issue; **transcendentalism** — A philosophical and social movement that developed in New England in the 1830s.
