assassination — The murder of a powerful person in a surprise attack for political or religious reasons; **colonization** — The sending by a country of a group of its citizens to settle and establish political control over a foreign country; **consumerism** — In this case, a negative term for the preoccupation of society with acquiring consumer goods; **disenfranchise** — In this case, to deprive someone of the right to vote; **migration** — The movement of a type of animal from one region to another, regularly according to the seasons; **monarch** — In this case, a type of orange and black butterfly native to North America; **poll tax** — In this case, a tax on voting; **refugee** — A person who has been forced to leave their home in order to escape war, persecution, or natural disaster; **voter fraud** — The illegal interference with the process of an election.
